At Totterdown Preschool our wish is that every child thrives and develops independence. To achieve this we would like to work with yourselves to get the best out of your child's time at Preschool.

We ask that you...

- Arrive promptly for pick up and drop off times.
- Take responsibility for initiating toilet training when your child is showing signs of being ready: can verbalise the urge and acknowledge the act.
- Introduce routines that benefit your child ie bedtime, mealtimes.
- Promote independence ie un/dressing, walking in etc
- To teach and model respect and tolerance of everybody regardless of culture, lifestyle, appearance, race or sexual orientation etc
- To engage in dialogue concerning your child whether in person or through media ie tapestry

We will...

- Provide a safe, nurturing environment where your child feels safe and cared for and able to take risks in a controlled environment.
- To promote good practice routines that will aid in the transition to school.
- To model good behaviour, manners, respect and attitude towards others and things.
- To educate your child in the 7 areas of the EYFS, concentrating, primarily on the 3 prime areas.
- To provide verbal and written reports on the progress of your child.
- To take care of your child's personal needs and support in helping them to learn to 'do it themselves'.
- To work in partnership with parents and other agencies for the good of your child.
